# REGISTERING YOUR NEW ESTABLISHMENT





To hire and process employees it is vital that you register your new establishment with the Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) first. To do so, simply follow the steps outlined below.

What is the LMRA?

The Labour Market Regulatory Authority (LMRA) is an entity that regulates and controls work permits for foreign workers in Bahrain and the self-employed, in addition to issuing licenses for manpower and recruitment agencies.



Copy of Passport and ID Card





Copy of Commercial Registration (CR) Certificate



Power of attorney (POA) or Board Resolution (BR) for the authorized person or legal office to open your LMRA account on your behalf

#### **REQUIRED STEPS**





Visit the LMRA in-person to initiate the steps below. To expedite the process, we recommend that you go through the Executive Service Centre in the LMRA.

During your visit you will need to:

- A Visit the <u>EMS system</u> web page and fill out the required fields
- B Upload the required documents (mentioned above)
- Submit the registration
- Print the registration form



After your submission:

- You will receive a confirmation via email and SMS once the establishment registration is approved.
- B You will then be redirected to pay the admin fees to complete the establishment registration.
- Then, you can take advantage of the EMS System.

\*You will need an eKey to access the EMS system.

## **APPLY FOR NEW WORK PERMITS**





When hiring employees to help take your business further it's essential to issue new work permits for them with the LMRA. Here's your easy guide on how you can apply.

#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**



Employee's passport



Signed offer letter or work-contract template (signed by both employer and employee)



Medical check-up report for the foreign employee



Employee ID Card (if available)

### **REQUIRED STEPS**

Login to the <u>LMRA EMS</u> system and start the process of applying for a new work permit

Submit the required information for the new employee

O3



Submit all required documents including the medical check-up report

Submit the application

Once the application is approved, download and print the official work permit from the EMS system and present the printed permit to the <u>Nationality</u>, <u>Passports and Residence Affairs</u> (Immigration Office).

If the biometric data was not previously collected, <u>book</u> and attend the employee's biometric data collection.

Book an appointment to issue the employee's official ID card through Bahrain.bh.

As you grow your business, your workforce will need to grow too. So, when you require an increase in the ceiling of work permits for your company, simply follow the steps below to issue a request to the LMRA and get up to 6 or 10 work permits depending on your activity.



Commercial Registration (CR)



Recent bank statement of the establishment (last 3 months)





Latest electricity bill (last 3 months)
\*Should not be a disconnection notice



Photos from the interior and the exterior of the establishment premises



Proof of work volume (e.g., contracts/invoices/customs papers, depending on activity)

#### **REQUIRED STEPS**

After submission, you will be notified to pay the admin fee.



LMRA will verify and confirm your application for the ceiling increase. Once approved, you can then apply to add new work permits.
